Sixth Form Uniform Policy

Sixth Form students at the school wear a uniform. This is an important part of our Sixth Form ethos: the objective is that the young adults in our Sixth Form dress in a manner appropriate for learning. Sixth Form students are expected to set a positive example to the younger members of the school community.

- Sweyne Park Sixth Form tie
- White shirt
- Plain black woven fabric, non-stretch, tailored, regular fit trousers or plain black knee-length tailored skirt (no skin-tight trousers or jeans please)
- A plain black V-neck jumper may be worn underneath blazers during cold weather
- Black ankle socks, or black or flesh coloured tights
- Sensible leather/man-made black shoes (no leisure shoes please)
- Plain outdoor, waterproof coat (no denim please)
- There is no requirement to wear school PE kit for Wednesday afternoon sport. Sportswear should be appropriate for a learning environment. Those studying PE A Level should wear a Sixth Form PE polo shirt for practical lessons.

Please note that:

- One small plain stud in each earlobe is accepted (no earrings, stretcher earrings or facial piercings please). **NB** We consider stretcher earrings to be potentially dangerous.
- No other jewellery should be worn except an inexpensive wristwatch
- Make-up should be discreet
- Extreme styles or colours of hair are not acceptable
