Dear Parent/Guardian,

Your child applied to participate in the Duke of Edinburgh Bronze Award and has been successful.

Duke of Edinburgh is an internationally recognised award and highly regarded amongst employers. It provides participants with the challenge of a walking expedition over 2 days.

The pupils will learn and enhance their level of map skills, including using compasses, pacing, bearings, OS maps and scale. They will create their own routes and therefore be confident in group work independent from the DofE leader. Over the expedition they will develop teamwork, co-operation, resilience, determination, perseverance and tolerance, as they are tested to new levels.

Alongside preparing for the expedition all participants will be devoting an hour a week to each of the following sections: volunteering, skill and physical. Participants can volunteer at an organisation e.g. charity shop; learn a new skill e.g. guitar; and develop a physical activity e.g. football, netball etc. Whilst developing their chosen areas, they will need to collect evidence of this for up to 6 months.

Please ensure the following dates are possible before enrolling and payment is made:

Practice expedition	Group 1 - 11 th & 12 th June 2023 Group 2 - 18 th & 19 th June 2023
Assessed expedition	Group 1 - 2 nd & 3 rd July 2023 Group 2 - 9 th & 10 th July 2023

Attached is an enrolment form to be completed before pupils can be registered. This needs to be done by Monday 6th March to confirm places.

There will be an evening to introduce the Duke of Edinburgh Award and give expedition information to parents and candidates on the Tuesday 7th March, 5:30-6:00pm in the Media Block

Payment sum of £70 needs to be paid by Friday 3rd March.


This trip will be covered by school insurance and accompanied by members of staff. This trip requires us to pre-purchase specific items required for the activity to obtain the best price. Therefore, we will be unable to offer a refund unless there are exceptional circumstances in the event of your child being unable to attend the trip.
