Dear Parents/Guardians,

Disneyland Paris Residential Trip 2024

On 25th February 2024, as part of your child's studies into Business and Economics, we are organising a trip to Disneyland Paris to take place between 25/02/2024 – 28/02/2024.

Disney is one of the worlds largest organisations in the entertainment industry and there is no better way to inspire our sixth form students than on an educational trip to Europe's biggest attraction. We have devised specialist programmes and study visits for Year 13 A-Level and CTEC Business and Economics students. As well as having some of the most iconic landmarks in the world, our Business educational trip to Paris will also offer a fantastic and diverse range of educational visits including attendance to the annual 'Business Live Conference', where students will gain invaluable insights from leading industry professionals. In addition to this, students will experience Disney parks at their leisure with their 2-day ticket.

The details of the trip are as follows (Subject to Confirmation):

Date:	Sunday 25 th February 2024 – Wednesday 28 th February 2024
Venue:	Marne-la-Vallee, Disneyland Paris
Accommodation:	Students accommodated in quad rooms, with four bunks
Time of Departure:	Sweyne Park School Bus Bay. Time: TBA
Time of Return:	Wednesday evening (time TBA)
Meal Plan:	Breakfast and evening meals at the hotel are included. Students advised to bring their own money for lunch and snacks during the day.
Mode of Transport:	Coach and Metro
Cost:	£900
Available Places:	The number of places available on the trip is limited to 30. In the event of the trip being oversubscribed, we will carry out a selection process taking in to account each applicant's effort grades rather than a first come first served basis. Where effort grades are the same, a random ballot will be used. If we are unable to offer your son/daughter a place, their name will be added to a reserve list.

Please do not pay any money until your child has a letter informing them that they have been successful in obtaining a place on the trip. At this stage, please just return the consent form to Pupil Services by 20th March 2023. A deposit of £150 will follow shortly after the deadline.

This trip will be covered by school insurance and accompanied by members of staff. In the event of your child being unable to attend the trip we will not be able to offer a refund unless there are exceptional circumstances. You are directly responsible for ensuring passport is 6 months in date. It is advised your child is fully vaccinated from Covid-19 in the event of changes to guidance.
