'Mrs Doubtfire' Theatre Performance Visit 21.9.23

The Resource Base for Deaf Pupils is planning to take all pupils to watch a performance of 'Mrs Doubtfire' at the Shaftesbury Theatre, London on **Thursday 21**st **September 2023.** This performance will feature British Signed Language Interpretation.

The performance is a matinee showing at 2.00 pm and pupils will attend school in the morning before departing at approximately 11.00 am to go to the theatre. We will be travelling by train and tube and will walk to Rayleigh Station together to and from school. We hope to return to school by 7pm although this will be confirmed nearer the time. Parents will need to make their own arrangements to collect pupils from the school as transport will not be available at this time.

The cost for this trip is £25 which covers the cost of the ticket. The Resource Base for Deaf Pupils will be subsidising transport.

Pupils will be asked to bring a packed lunch and drink to be consumed on the train. Pupils will not be allowed to eat whilst watching the performance as this can be distracting for other audience members. Pupils will be required to wear their school uniform for this visit.
